SUMMER CELEBRATION HELPS DES MOINES FAMILIES EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

Event celebrates efforts of volunteers, donors and supporters who helped 23 adults and 41 homeless children in 2018, while silent auction raises funds to assist more in the future.

Des Moines, Iowa — Family Promise of Greater Des Moines will host its annual Summer Celebration and Silent Auction to support families experiencing homelessness on Friday, June 28 from 7 p.m. – 9:30 p.m. The event features music, food and a 50/50 raffle and silent auction. The celebration will take place at the Giovannetti Shelter at 9000 Douglas Ave. in Urbandale.

In addition to raising funds, the celebration will highlight accomplishments of the organization's guest families in finding income and transitional or permanent housing over the last year.

"Our partnership with 14 faith-based host congregations is critical to helping families in their greatest time of need," said Jim Cain, Family Promise of Greater Des Moines executive director. "It's important that we acknowledge and celebrate all the people who give their time and treasure to help make our community stronger."

Each host congregation provides volunteers and space to serve Family Promise guests with overnight shelter for one week at a time. During the day, guests are transported to the Family Promise Day Center, where they receive case management services.

"Our guest families have told us that beyond the food and assistance volunteers provide, the moral support, encouragement and friendships they offer are really what gives families hope to lift themselves back out of the devastating circumstance of homelessness," Cain said. "We emphasize that our families are *experiencing* homelessness, they are not permanently bound to it."

During 2018 alone, Family Promise of Greater Des Moines provided overnight accommodations, meals and employment support to 23 adults and 41 children, approximately 15 of which were under the age of five.
